RCONA Executive Reports

<u>Approval of August 20, 2015 Minutes</u>: Hearing no objections, the Vice-President ordered the minutes approved as submitted and placed on file.

Receipt of Treasurer's Report: Hearing no objections, the Vice-President ordered the Treasurer's Report dated January 1, 2015, to September 16, 2015, placed on file as submitted.

<u>Public Comment:</u> Cindra Patrick mentioned that a recent news item mentioned Roseville, CA., as the home town of actress Molly Ringwald. April Marskell thanked the Quail Glen neighborhood members for their assistance raising donations for a family that was a victim of the recent forest fires (raised through Nextdoor.com)

Guest Speaker: Placer County Probation Department

Aaron Johnson introduced Brian Passenheim and Melanie Esque, and gave a 20- minute presentation on the overall operations and statistics of the Placer County Probation Department and their expanding community outreach programs. They oversee approximately 3,000 probationers a year, including both intensive (2 or more monthly contacts) and minimum (less strict for those offenders with no prior history) probation monitoring forms. They also have specialized programs: Alcohol monitoring, Electronic Monitoring (EMP) and special operations concentrating on Warrants, DUIs, and sweeps (especially on sex offenders). They discussed the local Roseville "Prep Center" which opened last month in Roseville—it provides local opportunities for probationers to complete required court-ordered classes and learn vocational skills, with emphasis on successful completion of probation and a reduction in recidivism.

One item that RCONA members found most interesting is their early intervention process—allows schools to refer youths exhibiting potential behavioral concerns; probation can provide counseling/alternatives to help lead away from more serious behavioral issues developing. Mr. Johnson said Placer County Probation's number one concern is community safety. You may find more information on the Placer County Probation website.

Round Table

<u>City of Roseville:</u> Sean Bigley gave the following updates on behalf of Megan MacPherson:

- Mayor Carol Garcia gave the State of the City address at the Galleria on Sept. 16; Jim thanked Sean and Megan for including the references to RCONA in the program and video (which mentioned our RCONA Conference and congratulated our 20 active neighborhood associations). The speech can be viewed on the web.
- 10/10/2015—Medication Take Back Day 9Am-Noon at three locations—Kaiser Roseville, Roseville High, and the Timbers Lodge at Sun City. Reminders given not to dump in the trash or down the drain.
- August water consumption showed a reduction of 37.2%; total January to present is 32% (above the state's mandated 28%). However, the City may require a reduction in one day

- per week watering to begin in October—Monday would be the watering day. A newsletter will come out within the next two weeks.
- Mayor Garcia and the City Council have expressed concern and opposition to the proposed SB20 pending in the state legislation. This would impose a new water surcharge tax on everyone, and the state will determine any future usage of the funds. Sean can provide more info if you are interested.
- Loren Cook asked about all the tankers they've seen filling up at the recycled water pumps in West Roseville. Sean acknowledged that the City is selling recycled water to developers and agencies and the money goes back into the Utilities Fund.

<u>Meadow Oaks</u>: Maxine Sarmiento said they will have a Spaghetti Feed fundraiser (\$15 for family of 4) at their Election meeting on Oct. 22nd at Alta Manor (she indicated Alta Manor will be changing its name). They need more volunteers for board members and to deliver newsletters.

<u>Sierra Vista</u>: Ann Newberry indicated they will start planning in January for a future yard sale.

<u>Highland Reserve</u>: Kathy Johnson said their Garage Sale is set for Sat. Sept. 19 (\$10 donation per participating home); Their general election meeting will be held in November.

<u>South Cirby</u>: Colleen Cole stated their Garage Sale will be Sept. 26 8AM-1PM; donuts and coffee will be offered for sale. Oakmont High School will be holding its 50th anniversary that same day.

<u>Junction West</u>: Liz Bunker indicated a rash of burglaries has revived interest in the NA and increased their Nextdoor group to 400 members now.

Roseville Heights: Barbara Harmon said they are having trouble getting out their newsletter.

<u>Hillcrest</u>: Lisa Morris said they are looking to transition to an email newsletter.

<u>Woodcreek Oaks</u>: Guru Niyam Seyl announced they are trying to promote a 'box top' drive for their schools.

<u>Technology</u>: Loren Cook announced the website training—Sept.28 and 29; sign up with Loren. He also said Nextdoor has not provided a connection tool to link with other websites yet.

<u>CGTM</u>: Cindra Patrick said their nominations will be announced at their next meeting, and the election will be held Oct. 22; they have obtained two more sponsors for their newsletter.

<u>Cresthaven</u>: Doris Jones said they held their second meeting; they are reaching out to businesses for sponsorships and are looking at developing a business directory on their website. They are planning a Fall Faire in November and an "Identify the Landmark" contest.

<u>Fiddyment Farm</u>: Sue Cook said their Annual Election meeting will be Oct. 14 and the High School District superintendent will be present to discuss the 6th high school and future redistricting of all the schools. The meeting will be a joint one with WestPark NA which FFNA has been helping to revive.

<u>Crime Stoppers</u>: April Marskell announced the Sept. 24th meeting 5:30 PM at the Blue Line Art Gallery; the event will honor police/fire/and a local citizen that have made a difference in the community.

<u>Pleasant Grove</u>: Scott Alvord said their Election meeting will be held Sept.22 6:30 PM at Misty Woods; they are ready to start their BOO Campaign beginning in October.

<u>Maidu</u>: Jim Kidd distributed his newsletter and announced a park Clean-Up event at Maidu Pavilion Oct. 24 10AM, a BBQ will follow and awards given for the most unusual items collected.

<u>Roseville Police</u>: Sgt. Bosworth gave the following updates:

- Burglaries to garages were down—believes that NAs warning neighbors to keep garage doors closed has been helping. (Garage burglaries were 33% of total burglaries in the City.)
- New increase of stealing tires from cars—mainly in apartment complexes; cars are left on blocks.
- Eich School incident—a man grabbed a girl, the man was arrested; Colleen Cole mentioned other incidents the man may have been involved in but nothing had been reported. Also a girl and her brother were approached in the Crestmont area by a different suspect.
- Circus Vargas was in town—Sgt. Bosworth said he was invited as a guest Master of Ceremonies.
- RPAL fundraiser—Bacon & Brew Bash—will be held Oct. 3, must be 21 (more info available on their website).
- Tech Teens starts Oct. 7th—RPAL sponsoring sign ups now, only 28 slots open for high school students interested in law enforcement tech tools. Call RPAL 772-7725.
- Cindra Patrick thanked Sgt. Bosworth for all the police and RPAL volunteers that helped at the Cherry Glen/Theiles Manor NA Cleanup event; they also expressed their thanks to Mayor Garcia who authorized additional pickups.
- Ann Newberry inquired about the lack of police and fire coverage at NNO; the schedule seemed to be a problem—several NAs did not have any appearances and others had many officers present. Suggestions made to coordinate for better scheduling next year.

<u>Kaseberg</u>: Elissa Schrader mentioned that the Roseville Historical Society is having its 4th annual fundraiser, Oct. 4th spaghetti feed at Memorial Park--\$15 for one/\$25 for two.

Agenda Items & Committee Updates

Sue Cook passed out Office Depot discount cards—good for discounts for items and printing (RCONA is a member of the Chamber of Commerce which coordinates for the discounts.)

Santa in the Park: Sue Cook gave updates on:

- contacts made with vendors and entertainment; contact Sue if you have any additional ideas.
- confirmed—facility, Santa, Fire Dept., train, Vencil Brown choir
- school decorations—general approval to send out school invites to take to school to drop off.
- We need volunteers (lunch will be provided); Maxine mentioned that volunteers should stay or return for cleanup as well.

<u>Elections:</u> Sue Cook mentioned that RCONA members can help each other with elections, just let one of the E-Board members know and we'll try to arrange help. Jim referred members to the Election Procedures and samples Sue recently distributed and have been posted on the RCONA site. Jim also said RCONA will elect its Nomination Committee at the October meeting and members should let Jim know if they wish to be on it. Sue reminded Reps to make sure they get any missing NA documents needed turned in this month—NAs will be certified for "active status" at the October meeting.
