Special Agenda Item by Steven Parker: RCONA Scholarship Presentations:

Scholarship Chairperson Steve Parker gave introductions of two of the 2022 Scholarship winners: Gavin Valdemoro (Roseville High School) and Ryan Santos (Woodcreek Oaks High School). Each student gave brief background statements, and then Sue Hallahan-Cook presented them their Award Certificates and thanked them for their community service. [RCONA also wants to acknowledge two Scholarship winners not able to appear at the meeting: Jenna Burd and Nicolai Neilsen, both from Woodcreek Oaks High School.]

Minutes: The minutes of the May 19, 2022 meeting were accepted with no amendments and ordered placed on file.

Treasurers Report, Melinda Surmani: Written Treasurer's Report submitted, no comments made, directed to be placed on file.

Public Comment: None

Roseville Police Update, Officer Lt. Miszkewycz: Mentioned the following:

- Taco with a Cop event at Weber Park Tues. 6/21 from 5-7 PM.
- Door Knock program--Patrol units may wake up citizens to inform them if their garage doors are left open.
- Reminders—do not leave animals in cars or areas exposed to excess heat.
- New City budget approved last night providing for new positions, PD will be hiring in the next months.

Roseville Fire Department Update, Jaime Garrett : Mentioned the following:

- Controlled burn will be held off Fiddymont Road near Athens on Fri/Sat 6/17-18 between 10 AM – 4 PM. The fire prevention measure is used as a training program as well.
- Fireworks--legal booth sales begin 6/28 through July 4th; police and fire units will be diligent.
- At the Grounds will provide fireworks around 9:15 PM, check parking availability on their Facebook site.

Roseville City Update, Jaime Garrett for Brian Jacobson:

- City budget approved last night.
- The Spring Cleanup was added to the approved General Fund budget for next year.
- Operation Swim happening next week; helps provide assistance for underprivileged children.

- City only has one official ‘cooling center’, but there are other places residents may go to cool down.

Agenda Item by Kevin LaChance: RCONA Logo

With Brian Jacobson’s assistance and the City graphics designers, two option packets were submitted to RCONA as a possible new logo. Kevin introduced the logo option selected by RCONA’s Executive Board at its last meeting—the option with ‘houses and people’, and showed the logo variations we’d be using from the choices submitted. Melinda’s motion was moved and seconded to approve the selections as indicated and adopt the selections as RCONA’s new logo.

The motion to approve the City’s recommended selections (mainly 3 variations of the ‘Houses & People’ logo (excluding circle logos with writing inside the circle) proceeded by hand vote—10 ayes, 1 nay; motion carried. A meeting quorum was announced as present (11 NAs present).

An announcement of RCONA’s decision and thank you will be sent to the City assistants and RCONA logo committee members.

Agenda Item by Melinda & Jim: Spring Cleanup Project

The Cleanup project has been going well, one final zone left—two locations this weekend at Roseville High School and Saugstad Park. The Cleanup project was added to the approved general budget for next year. Jim and Melinda, as co-chairs of the committee, will meet with EU organizers for debriefing; submit comments to Jim and Melinda. Two items noted so far by many of the project participants was that locations not be kept private on the websites, and to narrow down the event to two locations—one on west side and one on east side.

Neighborhood Round Table:

Cherry Glen: NA meets every other month. Had a presentation from Police Dept. for Senior Safety; held raffles to spark attendance; NA Board went on recent outing together.

Fiddymont Farm: Will hold NNO combined w/WestPark in August (other west Roseville developments not yet activated are invited to attend. Sue will invite vendors to participate. Cleanup Event was big success—9 heavily packed dumpsters (378 vehicles); we thanked Father Cliff and St. John’s assistants. More commercial sites ready to open.

Highland Reserve: Spring Cleanup went well—6 dumpsters, had to turn down some late-comers. Preparing rededication of Buljan Park—next Saturday at noon (funds raised to assist with this project).

Historic Sierra Vista: New NA signage installed; worked the voting poles as group fundraiser; will hold Nat. Neighborhood Day (Sept.); Says Enwood was coming to their NA, other board members encouraged them to refer Enwood members to Folsom Road NA (combined years ago).

Los Cerritos: Their Cleanup event is this weekend; they invited all to attend Taco with a Cop at Weber Park 6/21.

Maidu: Will hold Pancake Breakfast this Saturday with police participating as chefs—Maidu Pavilion 9-11 AM. Remind neighbors to check City's EU info for proper water scheduling.

Roseville Heights: Had good attendance at Weber Park event (20-30 people); City has made Weber Park a priority to improve the park with NA assistance; their Spring Cleanup is this weekend.

South Cirby: Will hold NNO in August; may switch their annual Garage Sale to springtime.

Stoneridge: Last meeting last month; will plan for Neighborhood Night Out.

WestPark: Working on social networking improvements, including drone videos.
