<u>Project Name:</u> I-80 Widening Tree Permit Extension

<u>Description:</u> The Placer County Transportation Planning Agency (PCTPA), in cooperation with the California

Department of Transportation (Caltrans), Placer County, and City of Roseville, propose to widen the existing Interstate 80 (I-80) adding fifth through lane from east of Douglas Boulevard to west of Riverside Avenue (where five through lanes currently exist). Due to the widening of the freeway, 283 native oak trees would be removed totaling to 2999" dBH. The project was cleared with a CEQA IS/MND prepared by Caltrans in 2016 and PCTPA (of which Roseville is a member of) filed a NOD as a Responsible Agency in 2021. A tree permit for this project was previously approved by the Planning Commission on September 22, 2022. The File # is PL22-0122. The tree permit will expire in March of this year and the request is to extend the tree permit for an additional 6 months

to expire on September 22, 2023.
